Topic: Economic Impact of Super Bowl XLV on the DFW Region



Bill Lively serves as President and CEO of the North Texas Super Bowl XLV Host Committee. Lively came to the Host Committee after nearly eight and a half years as President and CEO of the Dallas Center for the Performing Arts. He spent 25 years on the faculty and in the administration of Southern Methodist University, during which he founded the University's Symphonic Wind Ensemble, the Willis M. Tate Distinguished Lecture Series, the John Goodwin Tower Center for Political Studies, the Doak Walker National Running Back Award and SMU's Athletic Forum. Mr. Lively spent 23 years in service to the Dallas Cowboys and the National Football League, serving as director of the Dallas Cowboys Band and producer of Cowboys' game day entertainment. Mr. Lively produced entertainment for Super Bowls XII and XIII.

A native Texan, Bill Lively was raised and educated in Dallas. He holds a Bachelor of Music degree from Southern Methodist University and a Master

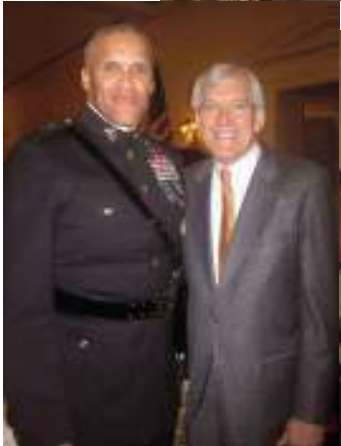
